III. CSUSA REPORTS

Chief of Schools Update

- Dr. David Christiansen, Chief of Schools CSUSA, thanked the board for attending the New American Hero event honoring the teachers.
- Dr. Christiansen updated the board on pending legislation that will allow CSUSA to continue
 the mobile learning model and being able to leverage the best teachers across the network
 of schools.
- Billie Miller noted that she has concerns for the teachers and schools if this is not implemented in a strategic way.

• Carissa Carrol, Principal at Bonita Springs Charter School ("BSCS"), outlined for the Board how BSCS is currently using the mobile model.

State Director Update

 Dr. Eddie Ruiz updated the Board on Executive Order 20 which outlined options for FSA grade reporting, high school graduation waivers, and creating a FAQ for parents to understand that they must bring students in person for testing.

Facilities Update

• The Board reviewed the Facilities Updates for all the schools in the Southwest Charter Foundation, Inc. portfolio of schools.

IV. FINANCE

FY21 Audit Engagement Letter

Litigation Update

 The Board discussed the litigation filed against Southwest Charter Foundation, Inc. with Board Attorney Levi Williams and Mr. Williams reiterated the stance that a public school cannot be charted a special assessment and that he will be filing a Motion to Dismiss on the Board's behalf. Mr. Wheeler asked for reimbursement for attorney fees.

Manatee Charter Application Update

The Board discussed the April 27th Manatee School Board hearing date and that Ms.
 Miller will be attending and representing the board at that meeting.

Charter Renewal Updates

 Rita Weaver updated the board that Collier School Board Attorney has sent over the contract for review and it is the model contract with some minor changes. The recommendation was for a 5-year renewal.

CARES Grants II Update

 Rita Weaver updated the board that districts are starting to announce the allocations for each of the schools and that the draft budgets are being submitted and will be brought before the board once the districts have approved them.

VI. NEW BUSINESS

Out of Field Waivers

The Board reviewed the out of field waivers for BSCS.

MOTION: Motion was made by Tom Wheeler and seconded by Billie Miller to approve the out of field waivers for Bonita Springs Charter School, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously.

School Year 2021-22

- The board reviewed the SY22 calendars which noted the following:
 - o Collier Charter School calendar follows Collier School District calendar
 - The Lee County schools under Southwest Charter Foundation, Inc. follow the district with the addition of three additional early release days for professional development: November 5, February 11, and April 22.
 - o Manatee Charter School follows the Manatee County district calendar except there are no early release days.

MOTION: Motion was made by Paul Sallarulo and seconded by Dennis Clark to approve the SY22 Calendars for the Southwest Charter Foudnation, Inc. portfolio of schools, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously.

- The board reviewed the Security Contracts and Coverage to comply with the MSD law, which noted the following:
 - Collier Charter School has a SSO through the Collier Sheriff's Office at no cost and is awaiting contract from Collier Sheriffe;
 - o Bonita Springs Charter School, Gateway Charter School, Gateway Intermediate will maintain coverage through the Lee County Sheriff Office;
 - Midcape Globle Academy will maintain coverage with the Cape Coral Police Department;
 - o Manatee Charter School will contract with Dynamic Integriy Security.

MOTION: Motion was made by Tom Wheeler and seconded by Billie Miller to approve and authorize the Chairman to execute the Security coverage as outlined to comply with the MSD Security Law, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously.

The board reviewed the SY22 enrollment policy which complies with state statute.

MOTION: Motion was made by Billie Miller and seconded by Pat Smith to approve the Enrollment Policy for the FY22 School Year, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously.

Paul Sallarulo thanked Ken Haiko for his tireless efforts for the Board.
