- The board visited Duval Charter School at Scholars ("DCSA") and thanked Deputy Hamlin and the Principal for walking them through the school and the plan to improve student outcomes. The Board requested that the state team push in to support DCSA with administration, enrollment, and all operations etc. so that the leadership staff at the school can focus on instructional efforts.

The board discussed the QUEST process and who holds the individual schools accountable for implementing the initiatives as well as the Education Model with fidelity. The Deputy Directors are responsible for ensuring that the schools are following the Education Model with fidelity.
